# Organ Stop Pizza, Mesa, Arizona



*The Pipe Organ.* Organ Stop Pizza has been a fixture in the Phoenix, Arizona area for more than 30 years and features the largest Wurlitzer pipe organ in the world. The organ is called the Mighty Wurlitzer.

The large, ornate pipe organ sits on a stage above the picnic-style tables. At break time, the pipe organ floats down beneath the stage with the organist still playing.

Originally the pipe organ was built for the Denver Theater. It has close to 6,000 pipes, numerous percussion instruments, countless traps that are played by the musical staff. The organ music begins 30 minutes after opening and continues throughout the evening with occasional breaks.

*Song Requests.* When you visit Organ Stop Pizza, song requests are encouraged. Write your song request on a card provided on either side of the stage and drop it in the box on the front center of the stage.

*Cats.* When a song featuring cats is played on the pipe organ, a curtain above the Mighty Wurlitzer raises and four cats sing and dance to the music. Children are often entranced by this feature.

*The Pizza.* Organ Stop Pizza offers pizza, pasta, sandwiches, appetizers, ice cream, and beverages on the menu. They accept cash and checks, but not credit cards.
